

Clyde (Butch) Maryman Jr.

JOPLIN, Mo. - Clyde C. "Butch" Maryman, Jr., age 64, Joplin, passed away at 2:54 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 31, 2013, at his residence after an illness of several months.

Butch was born Oct. 13, 1948, in Joplin, Mo., to the late Clyde C. Maryman, Sr. and Anna L. McFarland Maryman and had lived in the Joplin area most of his life.

Butch was a member of the Joplin High School Class of 66. He worked at the former R & S Chevrolet for several years and worked at Joplin Freightliner Sales for 30 years in parts sales. He was a former member of the Joplin Elks Lodge #501. Butch loved NASCAR, the Missouri Tigers and the St. Louis Cardinals. He was a proud veteran of the United States Army and had served his country in the Vietnam War.
