

Richard “Rick” Roby

March 12, 1948 – October 22, 1994

Richard Roby, 46, Boise, Idaho, formerly of Joplin, died at 2 a.m. Saturday at his home after suffering an apparent heart attack.

Mr. Roby was born March 12, 1948, in Joplin. He attended Joplin public schools. He was a 1966 Joplin High School graduate. He served in the Strategic Air Command of the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam War and served several years in the U.S. Army. He was a student at the University of Idaho, Boise.
