

# **Jerry Snider**

Jerry H. Snider, 41, 1630 Moffet Ave., died at 8:35 a.m. Monday at St. John's Regional Medical Center, Joplin, after a long illness.

Mr. Snider was born Nov. 21, 1947, in Joplin, and was a lifetime area resident. He graduated in 1966, graduate from Joplin High School and in 1971 from Missouri Southern State College with a degree in business administration. He was manager of the former Ben Franklin store at 32nd and Main streets in Joplin, He also had managed the chain's store at Webb City for two years.
