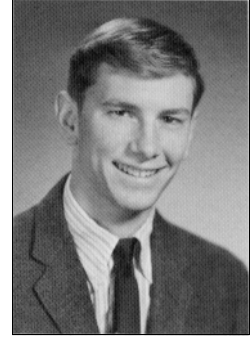


# Roger West

Charles Roger West, age 52, Joplin, passed away at 8:33 p.m. Sunday, April 8, 2001 at St. John's Regional Medical Center after a sudden illness.

Mr. West was born December 16, 1948 in Joplin and had lived in Joplin most of his life. He was a 1966 graduate of Joplin High School and a 1971 graduate of Missouri Southern State College, where he received a degree in Psychology.
